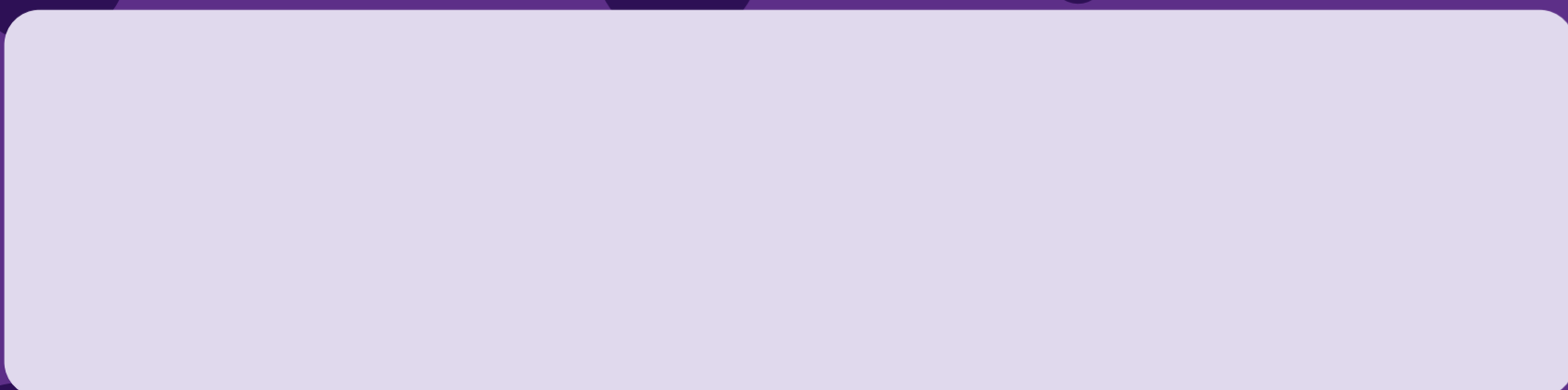
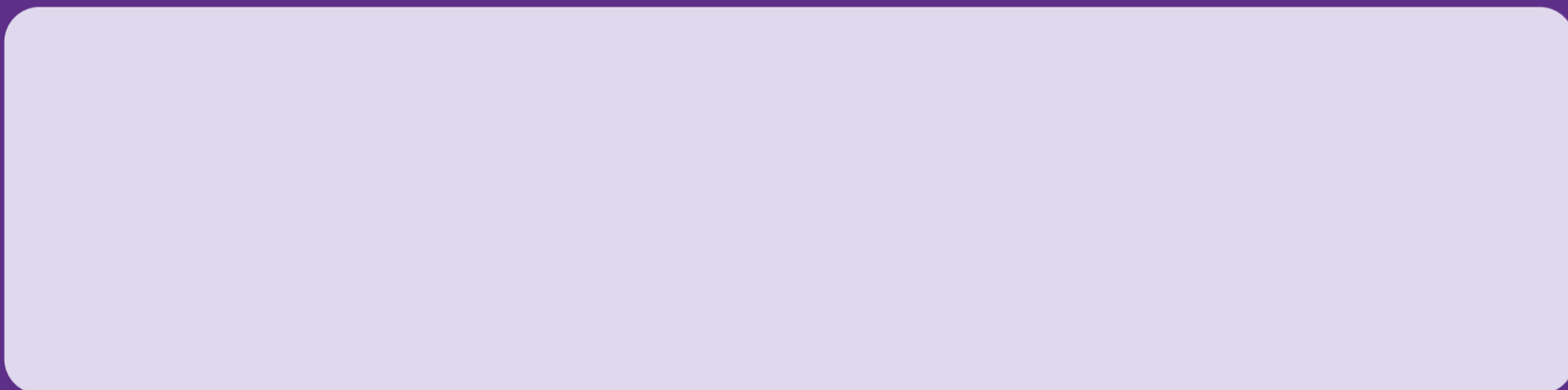
## Patriarchies
